In keeping with the not for profit, charitable mandate of WIO, 10% of any associated revenue generated through the ExpedNZ programmes is directed straight into the Whenua Iti Foundation. The Foundation was established to provide experiential learning programmes in support of the youth of our region.

ExpedNZ programmes allow you to access inspiring programmes whilst also supporting local communities. Every ExpedNZ programme contributes to the Whenua Iti Foundation to enable greater access to educational and therapy based programmes for those in need.

Access

ExpedNZ has Department of Conservation (DOC) concessions to access all three National Parks in the Top of the South Island. In addition we have permission to access privately owned wilderness areas not available to the general public.



Safety and Risk Management at ExpedNZ

Safety of our participants is of utmost importance to ExpedNZ. Our safety management systems and procedures have been developed over our 30-year history of providing outdoor experiences.

ExpedNZ is registered with WorkSafe NZ as a provider of adventure activities.

ExpedNZ is fully committed to achieving the highest possible standards of safety and to the continued development of safety management systems and procedures. Our safety management systems and procedures include, but are not limited to:

- An approved Safety Management Plan (SMP).
- A Safety Committee that oversees and governs all safety and risk management practice.
- A member of the Safety Committee (the On-Call Duty Officer) being on call and contactable at all times a programme is running.
- A staff competency system based on current best practice or industry standards and qualifications from relevant bodies such as the New Zealand Outdoor Instructors Association
- Risk Analysis and Management System (RAMS) forms for all activities

ExpedNZ is registered with WorkSafe NZ as an Adventure Activity Operator (AAO No. 177) as required by the Adventure Activities Regulations 2011.

ExpedNZ is subject to regular external safety audits as part of the Outdoors Mark audit certification. The register of adventure activity operators can be found on WorkSafe NZ's website - www.worksafe.co.nz














INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMMES



The Discover NZ programmes is specifically designed for international students who want to make the most of their holiday time in NZ. Join your fellow international students for a classic New Zealand experience.

Across this 10-day exploration programme you will travel to many of the most beautiful and iconic sites in the South Island. You will explore remote wilderness areas, access beaches and walks off the normal tourist trail, encounter wildlife, immerse yourself in a Māori cultural experience and truly discover New Zealand.

You will leave the programme with a greater understanding of life in New Zealand, of Te Ao Māori (the Māori World) and of the Kiwi people.

The Discover NZ programme starts and finishes in Nelson. The programme cost is all inclusive of food, accommodation, travel within programme, pastoral care and specialist equipment (tents etc).
